

**POSITION: TRANSPORTER**

Transports trapped cats to and from spay/neuter clinics

Estimated Time: Generally, transports are on Monday and Tuesday mornings and afternoons with a one-way time of about 1.5 hours/transport.

Skills:

- Hands on care
- Safe driving record
- Able to be on time to comply with clinic drop-off and pickup hours

Other:

- Large vehicle required, up to 10-12 cats in traps may be transported per trip

TASKS:

The volunteer for this position coordinates with the TNR Coordinator and Assistant TNR Coordinator and Overnight Caretakers. Tasks include the following:

- Load and Unload traps and carriers into vehicle
- Arrive at spay/neuter location in accordance with scheduled medical appointments
- Pickup animals from spay/neuter location in accordance with scheduled pickup time
- Collect invoices, medical records, and medication from spay/neuter facility and veterinary staff
- Return animals, invoices medical records, and medication to person providing overnight care of the animals
- Sanitize vehicle where cats are loaded.
